4. Aims and Objectives : The Aims and Objectives for which
Society is established are as under:-
- 4.1 To carry out research and other related activities in various legal and policy matters
for betterment of the society.
- 4.2 To identify regulatory challenges and carry out research and analysis of regulations
and decision-making process and tools used by the sector regulators. The area of
research includes telecom, insurance, electricity, petroleum and natural gas, road,
air port, major & minor sea ports, water, competition, capital market, commodity

market, environment and such other areas relating to the infrastructure sector to improve access to the same by the general public and overall development of the infrastructure sector.

4.3 To carry out policy research from various perspectives on infrastructure and urban development, to study the impact of multiple regulations on business eco-system, urban development and the environment for the benefit of the public in general and members of the Indian society in particular and not for earning profit.

4.4 To carry out various objects of the Society to serve the whole society without any discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, religion, race, sex and political or religious belief.

4.5 To engage with various regulatory authorities, government agencies, ministries in the Government of India, State Governments, Parliamentary Committees and other instrumentalities of the State, to participate in drafting of legislation and regulations, advise on proposed legislations, preparation of notes on legislation.

4.6 The Society shall work to promote, facilitate, undertake, support, guide, plan, manage or achieve the rapid all round socio-welfare development of the people i.e. individuals, families, communities and citizens in general by undertaking various

works on infrastructural, institutional, training or educational, financial and commercial know how.

4.7 To do advocacy and provide platform for discourse on efficacy of legislations, regulations and policy of the government for better governance, business eco-system and sustainable development with special focus on environmental concerns.

4.8 To publish journals, magazines and periodicals and other publications and research papers and reports on legal and regulatory issues concerning but not restricted to telecom, insurance, electricity, petroleum and natural gas, road, air port ,major & minor sea ports, water, competition, capital market, commodity market, environment etc.

4.9 To organise various media activities or set up, support, manage, provide leadership and every possible kind of information, education and communication works through interpersonal, field media, print media as well as electronic media projects to enable citizens to make their own efforts to improve their own quality of life by improving their awareness, attitudes and practice in a positive direction and to promote amity and understanding between the different communities and people of the world.

4.10 Engaging in regulatory consulting, including preparation of reports and analysis of data, research on legal, regulatory and policy issues either independently or in collaboration with individuals or societies or trusts or associations or other entities whether commercial corporations or non profit foundations domestic or international in any possible, feasible or suitable manner. The Society may use the resources, premises or facilities of it's members or let the members use the resources, premises or facilities etc. of the Society to achieve the objectives of the Society.

4.11 Collaborating with industries, industrial associations , consumers and consumer associations, universities and other institutions for advancement of the object of the society.

4.12 Collaborating with distinguished academics, scholars and practitioners, institutions, associations, corporate bodies, organisations, charitable or commercial, governmental or private and other international and domestic institutions for research and analysis and views from a variety of disciplines and for procuring opinions from them and to further the aims and objects of the Society.

4.13 To provide audit, advisory and consulting support and integrated services to all aspects of regulatory issues in infrastructure sector including urban development. To conduct seminars or other programmes to further the objects of the society.

- 4.14 To function as a centre for research and dissemination of information for know how, exchange of ideas and experience amongst the members of the Society and other agencies engaged in developmental work.
- 4.15 To establish developmental centres and training institutes in order to help people in regard to any aspect of development, to render advice on relevant socio-economic issues, developing resources and generally to help people and function as a link between people and the government and mobilise people's participation in the successful implementation of governmental and non-governmental policies and developmental programmes.
- 4.16 To study all aspects of socio-economic life and conducting necessary research thereon to improve quality of human existence and urban life. To inspire, lead, motivate and provide guidance and help which may be technological, managerial, financial, infra-structural support or know how support to the members of the Society and others to enable their involvement and to participate towards the Society's objects and activities.
- 4.17 To establish, maintain and manage research and training institutions for carrying out various research and analysis and dissemination of information by way of awareness programmes, conference, seminars etc.

4.18 To work as a development activities organisation to participate in and to influence political, social, economic, technological, ideological, economic, education and other aspects of development. To work on developmental strategies, pilot projects, institutional based or people based and to undertake research projects on any aspect of development.

4.19 To establish a trust for the management and administration of all the properties, moneys, assets and activities of the society.

4.20 To issue appeals and applications for money and funds in furtherance of the said objects and to accept gifts, donations and subscriptions of cash and securities and of any property either movable or immovable.

4.21 To invest and deal with funds and moneys of the Society and to vary, alter or transfer such investments from time to time.

4.22 To purchase or otherwise acquire or take on lease or hire in the Union territory of Delhi or outside, temporarily or permanently any movable or immovable property necessary or convenient for the furtherance of the objects of the society.

4.23 To sell, mortgage, lease, exchange and otherwise transfer or otherwise dispose of or deal with all or any property movable or immovable of the Society for the furtherance of the objects of the Society.

4.24 To undertake and accept the management of any endowment or trust fund or donation with objects similar to the objects of the Society.

4.25 To provide prizes, grant scholarship and stipends or provide monetary help in furtherance of the object of the Society.

4.26 To establish and maintain libraries and resource centres for facilitating the activities of the society and for the benefit of the general public.

4.27 To set up and undertake government aided projects.

4.28 To do all acts and things necessary for the advancement of the objects of the society.

4.29 All the income of the society will be utilised for the achievements of aims and objects of the society.

The above area may not be the only area. The society may do research, publication and advocacy in various other areas of law and policy making also.
